# Unswerving

Grade 3

Unswerving celebrates the extraordinary life and legacy of World War II Australian Army nurse Vivian Bullwinkel. Bullwinkel was the sole survivor of the 1942 Banka Island massacre in which she and twenty-one of her fellow nurses were marched into the sea and gunned down from behind by Japanese soldiers.

As she waded into the tranquil water of the picturesque bay, Bullwinkel recalls thinking "how could anything as obscene as this happen in such a beautiful place?" (Manners, Norman G. - Bullwinkel, Heperian Press, 2008, p 80.)

This image, a disjunction of circumstance and surroundings, permeates the opening of Unswerving. A dissociative effect is achieved through fading, superimposed triads and aleatoric use of finger cymbals representing glints of light on the ocean. This texture returns, like a recurring memory, punctuating the work.

A jaunty and rollicking second section (m. 33) muses on the spirited, mischievous nature of a newly enlisted young nurse. This stands in stark contrast to the third section (m. 122) with its raging percussion and muted trumpets in semitones - a testament to Bullwinkel's bravery, endurance and resourcefulness as she faced war, capture and imprisonment.

The jubilant and uplifting tutti finale of Unswerving (m. 167) pays tribute to Bullwinkel's remarkable legacy - survivor and witness, her service to humanity, her advocacy for university level training and improved salaries and working conditions for nurses.

Unswerving was commissioned by SCEGGS Darlinghurst in celebration of the school's 125th birthday.
